The job:

The *Senior Project Manager* is accountable for the development, implementation and ongoing management of complex growth projects for Xylowatt. He / She ensures that projects are constructed within time and budget constraints and in full compliance with local and regional, policies, procedures, rules, and regulations. This position organises, supervises, and leads the project team through project initiation and implementation, evaluates fee proposals; develops and manages project specific scopes, schedules and budgets.

Key responsibilities:

- Leads, coordinates, schedules, assigns, and inspects or quality checks the work activities of assigned staff, consultants and contractors on projects. Plans and controls all aspects of projects such as scope, schedule and budget. Successfully manages financial and technical aspects of projects. Supervisory and other duties as assigned.
